Sommario/riassunto	The monograph includes the results of research of the taxonomy, chemistry, ecology and distribution of <i>Stereocaulon alpinum</i> , <i>S. botryosum</i> , <i>S. condensatum</i> , <i>S. dactylophyllum</i> , <i>S. evolutum</i> , <i>S. incrassatum</i> , <i>S. nanodes</i> , <i>S. paschale</i> , <i>S. pileatum</i> , <i>S. saxatile</i> , <i>S. subcoralloides</i> , <i>S. spathuliferum</i> , <i>S. taeniarum</i> , <i>S. tomentosum</i> and <i>S. vesuvianum</i> in Poland. 1823 specimens from Polish and some European herbaria were examined. The occurrence of <i>S. spathuliferum</i> has not been confirmed during this study, therefore its status in Poland remains unknown. During the study three lectotypes were designated. The lichenicolous fungi, <i>Cercidospora stereocaulorum</i> and <i>Roselliniella stereocaulorum</i> on <i>Stereocaulon</i> were also noted. A key to known <i>Stereocaulon</i> taxa in Poland, including <i>S. spathuliferum</i> is provided.
