Sommario/riassunto	<p>This book explores the secrets of the extraordinary editorial success of Jacobus Acontius' <i>Satan's Stratagems</i>, an important book that intrigued readers and outraged religious authorities across Europe. Despite condemnation by the Catholic Church, the work, first published in Basel in 1565, was a resounding success. For the next century it was republished dozens of times in different historical context, from France to Holland to England. The work sowed the idea that religious persecution and coercion are stratagems made up by the devil to destroy the kingdom of God. Acontius' work prepared the ground for religious toleration amid seemingly unending religious conflicts. In Revolutionary England it was propagated by latitudinarians and independents, but also harshly censored by Presbyterians as a dangerous Socinian book. Giorgio Caravale casts new light on the reasons why both Catholics and Protestants welcomed this work as one of the most threatening attacks to their religious power. This book is an invaluable resource for anyone interested in the history of toleration, in the Reformation and Counter-Reformation across Europe. .</p>

Note generali	The individual (as the name for that which is dispersed in the environment of the problem of the subject) is socially determined in its realization: the individual is formed (socialized, disciplined, subjectivized) – and must also, either parallel to or against this, form itself, self-direct its own individuation and authentication. Joachim Renn's study shows how `self-realization' as `differentiation' can be

the basic figure of a pragmatic sociology of the 'subjective' in society. The central theoretical problem then becomes the relationship between general forms of the genesis of subjective self-relations and the socio-historical variation of interlocking and diffusion of subject formats and subjective 'self-relations'.

Sommario/riassunto

Die Person (als Name für Zerstreutes im Umfeld des Subjektproblems) wird sozial zur Entfaltung bestimmt: Sie wird geformt (sozialisiert, diszipliniert, subjektiviert) – und muss sich zudem, parallel oder widerständig zur Formung, »selbst« entfalten, eigensteuern, individuieren, authentifizieren. Joachim Renns Studien zeigen: »Selbstentfaltung« als »Ausdifferenzierung« kann die Grundfigur einer pragmatistischen Soziologie des »Subjektiven« in der Gesellschaft sein. Das zentrale theoretische Problem ist dann das Verhältnis zwischen allgemeinen Formen der Genese subjektiver Selbstverhältnisse und der historisch-gesellschaftlichen Varianz des Ineinandergreifens und Auseinandertretens von Subjektformaten und subjektivem »Selbstbezug«.
