Sommario/riassunto	Humanity as never before shares a common destiny, whether it be in terms of the resources of the planet, the global environment, economic integration, or the movement of peoples, ideas, cultures. The People's Republic of China under the leadership of the Chinese Communist Party and its ?Chairman of Everything?, Xi Jinping, has declared that it shares in the destiny of the countries of the Asia and Pacific region, as well as of nations that are part of an intertwined national self-interest.
