Desdesdes their temporal aspect, all occurred prior to the writing of the Constitution of the United States of 1787. Although many were produced in England, all are directly related to the British colonies that initially formed the United States and with them once they became independent. thus marking a clear spatial limit. All are legal in nature:
