Sommario/riassunto	Although the Trafficking Victims Protection Act defined girls exploited in prostitution as child sex trafficking victims, these youth are often misidentified and marginalized. Due to victim inaccessibility, emergent research regarding the problem lacks theoretical framing or sufficient data for quantitative analysis. This study assesses an intergenerational path from caregiver adversity to child exploitation in prostitution drawn from Agnew's general strain theory using structural equation modeling. Findings supported the hypotheses, revealing that highly stressed mothers were more likely to a

Quel rôle la direction générale des Impôts a-t-elle joué dans ce mouvement de réforme ? A-t-elle approuvé son orientation libérale ? Quels furent les voies et les moyens de son influence ? Cet ouvrage ne se contente pas d'étudier la structure, la doctrine ou le personnel dirigeant d'une des plus grandes directions du ministère des Finances.
