Sommario/riassunto

This book constitutes the refereed proceedings of the 4th International
 Conference on E-Commerce 2003, held in Prague, Czech Republic in
 September 2003. The 42 revised full papers presented together with an
 invited paper and a position paper were carefully reviewed and selected
 from 108 submissions. The papers are organized in topical sections on
 auctions, security, agents and search, ebXML, modeling and
 technology, XML, design and performance, business processes, and
 brokering and recommender systems.
