Mark Twain's 1869 book *The Innocents Abroad; or, The New Pilgrims' Progress* is a humorous travelogue of a voyage Twain undertook two years earlier. He'd sent letters to the newspapers about his steamship voyage through Europe, Egypt, and the Holy Land, commenting the whole way in his honest, funny, and sardonic style. Only a few years after the Civil War, this six-month voyage on the steamer "*Quaker City*" was arranged by famous pastor Henry Ward Beecher and General Sherman (neither of whom made the trip).
