Sommario/riassunto

Teamwork is essential to improving the quality of patient care and reducing medical errors and injuries. But how does teamwork really function? And what are the barriers that sometimes prevent smart, well-intentioned people from building and sustaining effective teams? Collaborative Caring takes an unusual approach to the topic of teamwork. Editors Suzanne Gordon, Dr. David L. Feldman, and Dr. Michael Leonard have gathered fifty engaging first-person narratives provided by people from various health care professions. Each story vividly portrays a different dimension of teamwork, capturing the complexity-and sometimes messiness-of moving from theory to practice when it comes to creating genuine teams in health care. The stories help us understand what it means to be a team leader and an assertive team member. They vividly depict how patients are left out of or included on the team and what it means to bring teamwork training

into a particular workplace. Exploring issues like psychological safety, patient advocacy, barriers to teamwork, and the kinds of institutional and organizational efforts that remove such barriers, the health care professionals who speak in this book ultimately have one consistent message: teamwork makes patient care safer and health care careers more satisfying. These stories are an invaluable tool for those moving toward genuine interprofessional and intraprofessional teamwork.

Sommario/riassunto

The essays in this volume explore the diverse ways that late antique Greek and Roman authors drew upon images to describe the one God. They analyze the rhetoric of language pictures in theological discourses and literary texts from various disciplinary perspectives, as well as the use of images as strategies of persuasion and defense. Wenn antike Autoren (ungeachtet ihrer religiösen Ausrichtung) über den oder zu dem Einen Gott sprechen, verwenden sie eine bildhaften Ausdrucksweise. Der Begriff ‚Bild‘ subsumiert hierbei die rhetorische Stilisierung durch Tropen und Figuren, die Verwendung von Symbolen mit Verweisfunktion und graphische oder plastische Bilder in archäologisch-kunstgeschichtlichem Sinne. Die Beiträge aus der Klassischen Philologie, Theologie, Religionswissenschaft, Klassischen Archäologie, Iranistik und Judaistik thematisieren diesen vielschichtigen ‚Griff zum Bild‘: Sie stellen sich der Leitfrage, welche Bilder die Autoren bzw. Künstler mit welcher Intention verwenden, wenn sie die ‚Ein-heit‘ Gottes ansprechen und funktionalisieren. Der Fokus liegt dabei auf der ‚Rhetorik des Bildes‘, d.h. der Verwendung rhetorischer Mittel in theologischen Diskursen und literarischen Texten sowie dem Umgang mit Bild und Bildlichkeit in Persuations- und Abwehrstrategien. Alle Beiträge entstammen der gleichnamigen Tagung (26.-28.09.2013), die von Nicola Hömke, Gian Franco Chiaia und Therese Fuhrer an der LMU München veranstaltet wurde. Den Rahmen bildete das DFG-Teilprojekt „Monotheistische Rede in Prosa und Poesie der Spätantike“ unter Leitung von Therese Fuhrer.
