All of them, except Night and In the Name of God, are unpublished in Spanish. Night narrates the accounts of a Lisbon newspaper on the night of April 24th, when The Carnation Revolution begins. The Second Life of Francis of Assisi addresses current issues: capitalism, politics, elections, stock exchanges, and the devaluation of products and people.
