To counter these structures, the author proposes a form of "development-as-politics", in which local and international actors engage in selective, political interaction. Findings provide the starting point for practical alternatives that account for the voices of the subaltern and enable international NGOs to assume a role that supports rather than weakens local capacities. Julia Schoneberg's analysis is based on her field research in Haiti between 2012 and 2014. Her research interests include alternative approaches to development
