Sommario/riassunto	This ebook consists of a summary of the ideas, viewpoints and facts presented by Alexandra Kitty in her book "Outfoxed: Rupert Murdoch's War on Journalism". This summary offers a concise overview of the entire book in less than 30 minutes reading time. However this work does not replace in any case Alexandra Kitty's book.
