Sommario/riassunto	<p>En 1425, dos mercaderes de Barcelona, Joan de Torralba y For-tuny de Manariello, y uno zaragozano, Juan Feixas, deciden constituir una compania (posteriormente renovada y reestructurada) con el objetivo de comerciar en Aragon, Cataluna e Italia. De esta sociedad ha pervivido, excepcionalmente y en perfecto estado de conservacion, una parte de sus registros contables, once libros correspondientes a la gestion de Joan de Torralba, los cuales representan, sin embargo, una parte infima de los que debieron de generar los movimientos economicos de las dos sedes principales (Barcelona y Zaragoza), la delegacion de Tortosa y las plazas de Genova, Pisa y Venecia. De Aragon a Venecia estudia la actividad de la compania entre 1433 y 1434 en el contexto socioeconomico de la epoca, e incluye la transcripcion de uno de sus registros, el «Llibre major de comerc de llana blanca amb Italia».
