Following memory acquisition and consolidation, circumstances may arise that necessitate that initially learned behaviour is no longer relevant. The papers compiled in this Research Topic offer new and valuable insights into the mechanisms and functional implementation of extinction learning at its different levels of complexity, and form the basis for new concepts and research ideas in this field.
