In this unique biographical account, edited and published here for the first time, Muammad Kaml al-Dn al-Ghazz (1760-1799), the chief Shafi'i jurisconsult of Damascus, introduces us to one of the leading figures of early modernity, 'Abd al-Ghan al-Nbulus (1641-1731). Being al-Nbulus's great grandson, al-Ghazz had direct access to the family's collective memory through his parents and grandparents, as well as to his great grandfather's scattered memoirs. Written about fifty years after al-Nbulus's death, al-Ghazz's biography, al-Wird al-Uns, remains the authoritative account of the great master's distinguished career, covering many aspects of his life and work in breadth, depth, and sophistication unmatched by any of the competing biographies.
