Sommario/riassunto	<p>Em comemoracao dos 2400 anos da fundacao da Academia de Platao, o presente volume reúne dez contributos sobre a figura do fundador da Academia, sua escola e obra, bem como sobre a influencia por ele exercida em autores posteriores (da Antiguidade aos nossos dias) e rececao desse legado ao longo da historia. Em termos de tematicas abordadas, os primeiros cinco capitulos incidem na analise de conteudos diversos trata dos nos dialogos platonicos. Comecase por considerar a importancia do Fedro na concecao filosofica de um 'lu gar supraceleste'. Seguemse duas reflexoes sobre a paideia platonica, uma centrada n' O Politico, outra na analise das praticas desportivas n' A Republica e n' As Leis. Sao tambem perspectivadas as implicacoes (dramaticas/filosoficas) da origem multicultural das personagens n' As Leis, bem como a percecao do banquete como modelo de comunidade sobre a qual se constitui a comunidade filosofica. Os cinco capitulos restantes concentram a sua atencao na presenca em autores posteriores (do neoplatonismo a literatura contemporanea) do filosofo, da sua obra e da Academia. By celebrating the 2400th anniversary of the founding of Plato's Academy, this book gathers ten contributions concerning the founder of the Academy, his school and work, as well as the influence Plato exerted on later authors (from antiquity to the present), and the reception of his legacy throughout history.The</p>

themes explored in the five initial chapters focus on the analysis of various topics treated in individual Platonic dialogues. To begin, the Phaedrus is considered for its significance regarding the philosophical conception of a "supraheavenly place". The next two chapters reflect upon Platonic paideia, first on the pedagogical principles of The Statesman, and next on the analysis of sports activities in The Republic and in The Laws. The dramatic and philosophical implications arising out of the multicultural origins of the characters in The Laws are brought into perspective alongside an insight drawn from the banquet, considered a model on which a philosophic community can be constituted. The five remaining chapters have a general focus on Plato's presence in later authors (from Neoplatonism to contemporary literature), as well the influence of the Academy.
