Publishing Presenter: This author's research which will be presented in the conference and their manuscripts will be published in the conference's proceeding (SCOPUS indexed). 2. Non-publishing Presenter: This participant will present their paper at the conference, however they will not be publishing their manuscript in the conference proceeding. 3. Participant: Attending participants only (Students are included into this category). II. DEADLINES & TEMPLATES Publishing and Non-Publishing Presenters must submit their abstract within the conference submission timeline (by August 10, 2019) and follow the IC-ASEAN abstract guidelines and template. Specifically for Publishing Presenters, full papers may be submitted after the conference, the latest on September 20th, 2019. The conference abstract and paper guidelines can be found on the Registration page. Accepted files formats for abstract is only Microsoft Word. The abstract of a research paper consists summary of the article's purpose, main points, method, research findings, and conclusion. The abstract's length should be a minimum of 150 words and a maximum of 250 words and be confined within a single paragraph. While the first line of the abstract is not indented, the line containing the keywords that directly follow the paragraph should be indented. Acronyms or abbreviated words should be defined in the abstract.
