Sommario/riassunto	The idea that ""measuring quality is the key to developing high-quality

software systems"" is gaining relevance. Moreover, it is widely recognised that the key to obtaining better software systems is to measure the quality characteristics of early artifacts, produced at the conceptual modelling phase.
