Cet ouvrage nous introduit dans un domaine largement méconnu, fascinant pour beaucoup, irritant pour certains, suspect pour d'autres. Les sourciers radiesthésistes de la société rurale franc-comtoise sont des révélateurs d'eau, mais aussi de la société dans ce qu'elle ne dit pas d'elle-même ou, du moins, sans l'intermédiaire de la baguette de coudrier ou du pendule.
