Sommario/riassunto	Biography of the polymath, Lt Cmdr Rupert T. Gould (1890-1948), the man who, in the 1920's, restored the great eighteenth century marine timekeepers by John Harrison to their former glory. With his

encyclopaedic knowledge, he studied and wrote on subjects as varied as scientific mysteries (e.g. The Loch Ness Monster) and horology (timekeeping). - ;This is the story of Rupert T. Gould (1890-1948), the polymath and horologist.
