Sommario/riassunto

This volume constitutes the proceedings of the Fourth International
 Conference on Integer Programming and Combinatorial Optimization,
 IPCO '95, held in Copenhagen in May 1995 under the sponsorship of
 the Mathematical Programming Society. Integer programming and
 combinatorial optimization provide a fruitful theoretical and
 algorithmic basis for the solution of a number of optimization
 problems occurring in real-world situations, such as production
 planning and scheduling, routing, crew scheduling, or network
 construction. This volume presents 36 revised papers selected from a
 total of 105 submissions and offers a representative up-to-date
 snapshot on the state of the art in this interdisciplinary area of research
 and applications.
