Sommario/riassunto	This inderdisciplinary inquiry seeks to uncover how Buddhism was expressed during the waning years of indigenou political power in Asia's oldest continuing Buddhist culture. It focuses on King Kirti Sri Rajasinha and how he successfully revised Sinhalese Theravada Buddhism.
