Sommario/riassunto	In The distinctive terminology in Šar al-Kfiya by Ra l-Dn al-Astarb Beata Sheyhatovitch presents a structured and systematic study of a seminal treatise in the medieval Arabic linguistic tradition. The treatise's author, al-Astarb (d. circa 1289), is widely considered the most brilliant grammarian of the later classical period.
