Sommario/riassunto The book critically analyzes the ongoing changes in the regional, intra-

regional, and global dynamics of cooperation, from a multi-disciplinary and pluralist perspective. It is based on the insight that in a posthegemonic world the formation of regions and the process of

globalization can be largely disconnected from the orbit of the US, and that a plurality of power and worldviews has replaced US hegemony.
