Sommario/riassunto	The Codex 2161 from the Riccardiana Library in Florence is a mercantile medley written in the Venetian area in the first half of the fourteenth century. It contains a page of moral warnings, problems of mercantile arithmetic, some astrological notes, a treatise on plane and solid geometry and a trading practice, i.e. indications on prices, coins and commercial uses of the squares of Venice, Alexandria, Tunis, Clarenza, Laiazzo and, with unusual attention, of Apulian and Albanian ports. The medley, which has remained unpublished until now, despite being one of the oldest commercial documents in the vernacular, not only Venetian, is published here in full with linguistic annotations and a complete glossary -- Publisher's text back cover.
