It is the fastest growing area of dermatology, both in terms of treatment options and number of practitioners, and there is increasing patient demand as the population ages. The market is predominantly in the US (where there are approximately 10,000 dermatologists, at least half of whom perform complex cosmetic procedures on a regular basis) but there is also an important emerging market in Asia"--
