The FBI's Office of Integrity and Compliance (OIC) manages the program. The OIC's mission is to "develop, implement and oversee a program that ensures that there are processes and procedures in place that facilitate FBI compliance with both the letter and spirit of all applicable laws, regulations, and policies."
