Sommario/riassunto

Comment les oeuvres d'Herve Bouchard et de Michael Delisle abordent-elles la paternite ? Comment la fonction paternelle - au sens de la psychanalyse - est-elle revelee et subvertie au sein de leurs poetiques ? Pour parler de Bouchard, d'abord, l'auteur de ce livre fait un detour du cote de Freud et de son celebre Totem et tabou. Il revisite le mythe du pere de la horde et montre comment la prose bouchardienne est marquee par un desir de declarer le leurre suppose de la loi symbolique, desir detecte dans une entreprise de « totemisation » de l'ecriture. Puis, s'interessant a l'oeuvre de Delisle, il s'attarde a la conception lacanienne du mythe individuel afin d'analyser la tentative toujours reiteree de l'artiste d'atteindre le pere. Chez Bouchard et Delisle, la paternite est ainsi une place vide autour de laquelle les fils creent et se definissent. Ce parcours permet de degager un ressort poetique inedit : la pere-mutation. La figure du pere, disseminee et fragmentee dans les ecrits de ces deux auteurs quebecois contemporains, fait l'objet d'un travail d'elaboration poetique que la psychanalyse permet de reconnaitre. Louis-Daniel Godin l'observe et la dissequer avec une grande perspicacite fondee sur la connaissance profonde de ses sujets : litterature, paternite et psychanalyse.
