Sommario/riassunto	Jennifer Eastman Attebery offers a new perspective on Swedish immigrantsO experiences in Idaho, Montana, Utah, Wyoming, Colorado, and New Mexico from 1880 to 1917 by interpreting their letters home. Recognizing the lettersO power as a folk form, Attebery provides a model for discerning immigrantsO shared culture in correspondence collections and brings to life small Swedish communities throughout the Rocky Mountain region.
