Sommario/riassunto	Lance Massey and Richard Gebhardt offer in this collection many signs that composition again faces a moment of precariousness, even as it did in the 1980's - the years of the great divorce from literary studies. Composition is poised to move not from modern to postmodern but from process to post process, from a service-oriented ""field"" to a research-driven ""discipline.""
