Learning from the Field: Innovating Chinas Higher Education System presents first-hand experience and lessons from an innovative, participatory curriculum development initiative in China. It includes the content of two novel courses, Community Based Natural Resource Management and Participatory Rural Development. The first versions of these courses

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were delivered at the College of Humanities and Development of the
China Agricultural University in Beijing in the spring of 2005 and at the
Jilin Agricultural University in Changchun in the spring of 2006.
