specific policies and institutions created to support it, and the creation

of linkages among domestic firms and sectors. Avoiding macroeconomic instability is also essential, however, macroeconomic stability is not a sufficient condition for growth. The broader institutional context and the adequate provision of education and infrastructure are essential ""framework conditions"", but generally do not play a direct role in bringing about changes in the momentu
