This book contains all the exercises and solutions of Serge Lang's Complex Analysis. Chapters I through VI of Lang's book contain the material of an introductory course at the undergraduate level and the reader will find exercises in all of the following topics: power series, Cauchy's theorem, Laurent series, singularities and meromorphic functions, the calculus of residues, conformal mappings and harmonic functions. Chapters VII through XVI, which are suitable for a more advanced course at the graduate level, offer exercises in the following subjects: Schwarz reflection, analytic continuation, Jensen's formula, the Phragmen-Lindelof theorem, entire functions, Weierstrass products and meromorphic functions, the Gamma function and the Zeta function. This solutions manual offers a large number of worked out exercises of varying difficulty.
