With facing page Greek text and the first in-depth analysis in the form of commentary and individual studies on the hierarchy, the ceremonies, court attire, the Blachernai palace, lighting, music, gestures and postures, this

volume makes an important new contribution to the study of the Byzantine court, and to the history and culture of Byzantium more broadly.
