Sommario/riassunto	Ovid's 'Fasti, Book 6' is the last of his calendar poems. This book analyses Ovid's account of the festivals of June, and explores the subtle interrelationships of history, literature, religion, and politics in the Augustan age. It also explores the accuracy of Ovid's antiquarianism, and his expansion of generic boundaries.
