Sommario/riassunto	First performed at the Moscow Art Theatre in 1904, directed by Konstantin Stanislavski, <i>The Cherry Orchard</i> remains a classic of the theatre. Completed less than a year before his death at the age of forty-four, Chekhov's last 'comedy' still ranks supreme as a human tragedy of dispossession with audiences and actors alike.
