Sommario/riassunto	Antoni Gaudi i Cornet (25 juin 1852 - 10 juin 1926) est un architecte catalan. Diplome de l'Ecole d'architecture de Barcelone en 1878, il travaille des ses debuts avec l'architecte Josep Fontseres sur le projet du parc de la Ciutadella. Sa carriere commence vraiment en 1883, avec le debut de l'edification de la Casa Vicens. Jeune architecte, il est d'abord inspire par Eugene Viollet-le-Duc mais bien vite, il rompt avec le modele neogothique et se fait remarquer par son originalite et sa

fantaisie. Des ses premiers projets, il fait cohabiter architecture et mobilier. Inscrit dans la mouvance de
