This phenomenon has been far from uniform, however, and the considerable attention that the more successful Right-wing extremist parties have received has sometimes obscured the fact that these parties have not recorded high electoral results in all

West European democracies. Furthermore, their electoral scores have also varied over time, with the same party recording low electoral

scores in one election but securing high electoral scores
