Sommario/riassunto

Dieses Wörterbuch stellt den lexikalisch-semantischen Bestand des Demokratiediskurses der späten 1960er Jahre dar. Dieser Demokratiediskurs ist insofern als ein gesellschaftliches Umbruchphänomen zu beschreiben, als in den späten 1960er Jahren die intellektuelle und die studentische Linke Partizipationsansprüche einer konsequenten Demokratie für kurze Zeit in hoher kommunikativer Dichte und Intensität erhob. Die Folgen dieser demokratischen Neukonzeptionen prägen seither die Gesellschaften hinsichtlich ihrer Demokratiemodelle, in Bezug etwa auf Teilhabe, auf die Unabhängigkeit von parlamentarischer Politikpraxis sowie hinsichtlich des Anspruchs auf gesellschaftliche Mitgestaltung. Die Schlüsselwörter, in deren Bedeutung sich dieser Diskurs verdichtet, werden nach den spezifischen Prinzipien eines Diskurswörterbuchs, d. h. vor allem im Sinn eines diskursiven semantischen Netzes, beschrieben.
