## Sommario/riassunto

Treatment-resistant major depression and bipolar disorder are highly prevalent and disabling conditions associated with substantial morbidity and mortality. Providing a concise view of the current definitions, assessment and evidence-based management of such disorders, this resource reviews novel therapeutic targets, which may enhance the future therapeutic armamentarium of clinicians.

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
