Sommario/riassunto	This book examines the theological, philosophical and Islamic mystical dimensions of the Suhrawardi sufi order from the 13th to 15th centuries. The Suhrawardis were a legally grounded and intellectually vibrant sufi order whose mystical path was based on exchanges and debates on the Qur'an and on the Prophet's customs. The book analyses their interpretation of sacred texts: the Qur'an, hadiths, sunna, and malfuzat. This created a unique self-understanding, which developed specific sufi spiritual exercises.
