Sommario/riassunto	L'analyse de la vie publique d'Édouard Herriot (1905-1957) continue à être porteuse d'éclairages historiques multiples tant pour Lyon que pour la France et les relations internationales. En effet, pendant plus de 50 ans, Herriot a été maire de Lyon, député, ministre, président du parti radical et aussi de la Chambre des députés.
