Sommario/riassunto	Hegel makes philosophical proposals concerning religion and Christianity that demand critical reflection from contemporary theology. Hegel and Theology discusses the role that an understanding of religion and Christianity play in the development of Hegel's idea of philosophy; Hegel's treatment of religious experience, religious discourse, and cultic practice; the problem of the relation between the world and God and the issue of God's transcendence. Thesediscussions provide a framework for considering Hegel's understandings of specific Christian mysteries. Here De Nys considers the Hegelian co
