It is suitably basic for generalists, but it also covers more specialized procedures performed by colon and rectal surgeons, such as local resection of rectal cancer and advancement flaps. The topics are clearly and logically organized and include critical elements such as preoperative planning, positioning considerations, and step-by-step details of the procedure, which are accompanied by clear color photographs and illustrations. Readers should be aware that this book,

while broad, does not cover all anorectal conditions, only those with surgical corrections, which is in keeping with the authors' goals. This is a very useful book, particularly for trainees or for young surgeons who encounter anorectal conditions.
