| Sommario/riassunto      | <p>It hardly needs repeating that Plato defined philosophy partly by contrast with the work of the poets. What is extraordinary is how little systematic exploration there has been of his relationship with specific poets other than Homer. This neglect extends even to Hesiod, though Hesiod is of central importance for the didactic tradition quite generally, and is a major source of imagery at crucial moments of Plato's thought. This volume, which presents fifteen articles by specialists on the area, will be the first ever book-length study dedicated to the subject. It covers a wide variety of thematic areas, from the nature of the Platonic dialogues to the reception of Hesiod in the Platonic dialogues, and from the relationship between Plato and Hesiod to the relationship between Plato and Homer. The articles are written by leading scholars in the field, including some of the most prominent names in classical studies. The volume is an essential resource for anyone interested in the history of philosophy, the history of literature, or the history of ideas.</p> |
