Sommario/riassunto

Chaque année l'institut de recherche sur l'Asie du Sud-Est contemporaine (Irasec), basé à Bangkok, analyse les principaux événements politiques, économiques, sociaux, environnementaux ou religieux survenus dans l'ensemble du sous-continent asiatique. Établissant une rétrospective des faits majeurs de l'année 2013, ce livre aide à mieux comprendre les grands enjeux et les perspectives de l'année 2014 dans une région de près de 600 millions d'habitants qui,

plus que jamais, joue un rôle d'interface entre les grands pôles asiatiques et l'Occident. Grâce au travail de terrain tout au long de l'année d'une vingtaine de chercheurs et d'experts, Asie du Sud-Est 2014 offre un décryptage d'une actualité asiatique complexe, dense et dynamique. Outre une analyse claire et détaillée, Asie du Sud-Est 2014 propose trois dossiers et un débat sur des sujets d'actualité représentatifs des changements en cours. De nombreux outils pratiques sur l'Asie du Sud-Est sont également disponibles, au nombre desquels une chronologie des événements des douze derniers mois ainsi qu'une liste des principaux ouvrages publiés au cours de l'année. Il est augmenté pour la première fois d'un très utile inventaire des principaux think tanks en Asie du Sud-Est.

Sommario/riassunto

In *Ecocritical Explorations*, Patrick D. Murphy explores environmental literature and environmental cultural issues through both theoretical and applied criticism. He engages with the concepts of referentiality, simplicity, the nation state, and virtual reality in the first section of the book, and then goes on to interrogate these issues in contemporary environmental literature, both American and international. He concludes his argument with a discussion of the larger frames of family dynamics and un-natural disasters, such as hurricanes and global warming, ending with a chapter on the integration of scholarship and pedagogy in the classroom, with reference to his own teaching experiences. Murphy's study provides a wide ranging discussion of contemporary literature and cultural phenomena through the lens of ecological literary criticism, giving attention to both theoretical issues and applied critiques. In particular, he looks at popular literary genres, such as mystery and science fiction, as well as actual disasters and disaster scenarios. *Ecocritical Explorations in Literary and Cultural Studies* is a timely contribution to ecological literary criticism and an insightful look into how we represent our relationship with the environment.
