Sommario/riassunto	This publication relates the history of the tenement at 3 Uniwersytecka St. in ód, originally designed as a place of residence for the teachers of the Merchant Assembly School (Polish: Szkoa Zgromadzenia Kupców) of the city of ód (1898-1939). Since 1945 it has been a university building. It used to house the flats of the founding professors of ód University (including Professor Tadeusz Kotarbiski' s – the first rector of the University of ód) as well as science departments. Until the early 1990s, private and public space coexisted here, which made it a place with a special and unique atmosphere. The Scholars' House is also interesting when viewing the transformation of ód University, as it reflected the ups and downs of the university itself during the time of the Polish People's Republic. The book presents the story of the tenement at 3 Uniwersytecka St. and the complicated lives of its residents in postwar Poland. It also describes the difficulties of forming an academic environment in ód – a working-class city with no scholarly traditions.
