Sommario/riassunto

Als Fortsetzer des Kirchenvaters Hieronymus befasst sich Prosper Tiro als einer von wenigen zeitgenössischen Autoren mit der Geschichte des Weströmischen Reichs in der ersten Hälfte des 5. Jahrhunderts. In der Fortsetzung der Chronik des Hieronymus bis ins Jahr 455 gibt Prosper einen Bericht über seine Zeit, in dem er einzelne Ereignisse vergleichsweise genau datiert und eigene Wertungen hinzufügt. So

wurde er seinerseits zum Ausgangspunkt für weitere chronistische Darstellungen, von denen eine – der sog. *Laterculus Regum Vandalorum et Alanorum* – sich ebenfalls im vorliegenden Band findet. Der Text beider Quellen liegt nun erstmals in deutscher Übersetzung vor.
