When the curtains fell on the 'Thousand-Year Reich', in May 1945, SS-Brigadeführer Walter Schellenberg left for neutral Stockholm, only to be taken shortly thereafter to Frankfurt and London for interrogating. The 'Final Report' on the Case of Walter Schellenberg is the revealing product of those Allied interrogations. Reinhard R Doerries has written the first scholarly appraisal of Schellenberg as a Nazi leader and Hitler's final head of foreign intelligence.
