Sommario/riassunto	Das Werk von Friedrich Nietzsche hat stets polarisiert. Im 20. Jahrhundert entsprachen die Hauptlinien der Nietzschedeutung meist dem Grabenverlauf des Kalten Krieges. Daran konnte auch die Nietzscherennaissance wenig ändern, die von der enttäuschten Linken Westeuropas her allmählich in den Ostblock eindrang. Im Gegenteil: Die Nietzschedebatte kurz vor dem Ende der DDR und der sogenannte

deutsche Literaturstreit kurz danach bezeugten eindrucksvoll das Fortwirken liebgewordener Feindbilder. Die Literaturwissenschaftler Wolfgang Iser und Karl Heinz Bohrer agierten hien und drüben jeweils als Strategen von Weltanschauungskämpfen, die in den beiden Debatten kulminierten, sie aber überdauern sollten. Der Pazifist und der Bellizist, der Nationalkommunist und der Transatlantiker, der Heinrich-Mann-Preisträger der Ulbricht- und jener der Merkel-Republik verkörpern dabei in verblüffenden Parallelen den Typus Gesinnungskrieger, dem Nietzsche zum Ernstfall werden muß.
