Sommario/riassunto	Wie entsteht historische Information? Wie verschiebt sich der Blick auf die Technologien der Tradition, wenn er von der Geschichts- in die Medienwissenschaft wandelt? Es lohnt, sich für einen Moment von der Befangenheit im historischen Diskurs suspendieren und damit in Bereitschaft versetzen zu lassen, Signale aus der Vergangenheit mit anderen Sinnen zu empfangen. Wolfgang Ernst befasst sich mit den materiellen, technischen und symbolischen Operatoren der historischen Zeit und interpretiert deren Zeitweisen zugleich als Herausforderung des Begriffs der Geschichte selbst. Emphatische Zeitfiguren lösen sich bei genauem Hinsehen in diskrete Operationen auf; an die Stelle großer Geschichtsbilder tritt konkreter Symbol- und Signalvortrag, der an paradigmatischen, gelegentlich auch anekdotischen Szenarien anschaulich gemacht wird.

Sommario/riassunto	With the rise of China and massive new migrations, China has adjusted its policy towards the Chinese overseas in Southeast Asia and beyond.

This book deals with Beijing's policy which has been a response to the external events involving the Chinese overseas as well as the internal needs of China. It appears that a rising China considers the Chinese overseas as a source of socio-political and economic capital and would extend its protection to them whenever this is not in conflict with its core national interest. The impacts on and the responses of the relevant countries, especially those in Southeast Asia, are also examined.
